

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING  
QUALIFYING FEES FOR 2023 MUNICIPAL ELECTION**

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. Sec. 21-2-131 requires that qualifying fees for party and public offices be fixed and published; and


WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. Sec. 21-2-131 requires that the governing body of a municipality fix and publish qualifying fees for each of its offices no later than February 1 of the year the general election is to be held; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. Sec. 21-2-131 states the qualifying fee for each office to be filled in the upcoming election shall be three (3) percent of the total gross salary of the office paid in the preceding calendar year;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of West Point, Georgia, do hereby fix the qualifying fee for the office of Mayor at Two hundred fourteen dollars and twenty cents (\$214.20) and the qualifying fee for the office of Councilmember at One hundred fifty-one dollars and twenty cents (\$151.20) and do hereby publish the same.
